This fee is divided as follows: Transcript and certificate (shs.200,000/=), Graduation ceremony (shs.100,000), certification of two copies (40,000). The money should be deposited on URA Account. You should generate PRN via student@ldc.ac.ug.
- Certificates and transcripts will be issued on the day of graduation.
- The special and supplementary examinations will be conducted **during the subsequent intake.**
- Participants to sit special/supplementary exams will be required to pay Shs. **100,000=** per subject.
